This dance was devised for the three Societies that came together to jointly host a series of Balls – Northwich Scots' Society, RSCDS Cheshire and Nantwich & District Scottish Society.

THE WYCHES OF CHESHIRE (S3x32) 3C Triangular Set Liz Bruynooghe

- 1-8 All set to partners, Women dance into the middle, pass each other LSh and curve into the Woman's place to their right.(1W to 3M; 2W to 1M; 3W to 2M) All set to 'new' partner and turn 2H. Finish facing 'new' partner.
- 9-16 All dance interlocking RSh reels of 4 and end by turning 'new' partner ¾ RH to bring Men into centre.
- 17-24 Men dance LH across 1⅓ times round, finishing in triangular set facing original partner; all dance DoSiDo passing LSh. 2 3 1
- 25-32 All set and link; Women, followed by partners, chase clockwise two places, passing through original place and on bar 32 all pass partner RSh to form triangular set facing partners. 3 1 2.

Frank Thomson, our musician at the first Wyche Ball, has written a tune for this dance – he has named the tune "Liz" in tribute to the dance deviser.

Otherwise, if a recording of "Liz" is not available, the music for "A Tribute to Peter McBryde" is suitable.
